Greetings!

We would like to introduce you to 100 Women Who Care - Polk/Burnett. We are a group of like minded women serving as a platform to empower local non-profit groups. Each meeting our members donate \$100 directly to a selected charity and together we make a difference!

How it works:

Our group meets quarterly on the second Wednesday evening of February, May, August and November. Meetings include a 30-minute registration and social time followed by a one hour meeting. During the meeting time, four local non-profit groups will give a brief presentation to educate our members about their cause. At the end of the presentations, each member will vote anonymously for the group they feel is most deserving to receive our quarterly donation. The group receiving the most votes will be our selected non-profit for that meeting and receive a donation of up to \$10,000. The group receiving the second highest votes will be our secondary selected non-profit and receive the balance of the funds donated beyond \$10,000. Each member will immediately write a check for \$100 directly to one of our selected non-profits. All members must donate to our selected groups, even if they voted for another non-profit.

Non-Profit Group Selection:

Our quarterly presenters will be chosen at random from all applicants. All groups who apply must operate in Polk or Burnett, Wisconsin counties and have 501(c)(3) status. Once a non-profit is selected to receive our primary donation, they will be withheld from the drawing for a period of at least two years or until such time that all groups have had the chance to present, whichever is longer. Once a non-profit is selected as our secondary chosen non-profit, they will be withheld from the drawing for a period of two years. If a non-profit group is chosen to present, but is not chosen as one of our selected non-profits, they will be added back to the drawing after one year.

Membership:

We welcome all women to join our group! Your membership is a commitment to donate \$100 to a selected non-profit group on a quarterly basis, for a total donation of \$400 per year. *Please take this commitment into consideration before joining the group.* With that being said, we also understand that "Life Happens"! If for any reason you are not able to donate your committed amount at a meeting, it's okay! However, if you are unable to donate at two consecutive quarterly meetings, you will not have voting privileges at the next meeting. This process is discreet and private, you will not be singled out for having missed making donations. Your voting privilege will be reinstated after you make your next donation. If you are unable to attend a meeting, but would still like to donate, you can have another member vote for you and turn in your check or mail you check to us before the meeting takes place.
